## WATER OF THE SPRING

Walter S. Lapp of Philadelphia in 1926 submitted a paper that "investigated the normal water temperature" of Ingham Spring as part of his University of Pennsylvania degree requirements. The entire report is held in STHS's archives. Of interest is not only the yearlong report of water and surrounding temperatures, but also an analysis of the water including Bacteriological and Sanitary Chemical Examinations and water analysis.

The report may be of interest to those researching the current water quality and looking for comparative data. A table of contents follows:
