## 1. Web Site

Many, many thanks to Beth Carrick: the web site is now fully up to date with all past STHS and NHHS Oral histories posted. Beth did a fantastic job adding to the text, editing, creating the key word searches and organizing the fonts, colors and sections in a way that frames the story of Solebury thru the web's content.
