

1. finished 2014 with 75 oral histories in the collection.
2. Began dialogue with Historic Carversville Society about their tapes. Picked up two of them for initial work to see if we can keep going to post their collection and the new ones they do. They are somewhat active in recording new OH, some on Video.
3. Michener Art Museum work continues. Quite a few are in hand to post to the web with time. Robert has a further 10 +/- to get ready to post and there are then more than 30 to be transferred to disc and processed. Some of the ones we have done are wonderful. The "3d" Bye interview fits in perfectly with the Museum's current show of the artist's work. Others so so, and a number that are just for MAM's archives as they are not artists of note or of interest to STHS/Bucks County.

3a) The program to apply for grant money to support a professional OH project is progressing with MAM's Archivist Pam Sergey, the historian Thomas Delfi, Charlotte and Robert working to get the application shaped up. this would not be rewarded until late 2015, if we get it! Many thanks to Charlotte to the dogged work to keep this moving along. A great deal of paper and writing.
4. Jack Donohue has finished recording 5 different OH with Will Rivinus. All of these are processed and in hand to post, again when time permits. Jack is interested in doing more with other people in 2015.
5. Gayle Goodman has been contacted and she too is interested to do some recordings in 2015. Probably beginning after March.
