

1. Michener Art's Museum (MAM) archived tapes project is moving along. 11 tapes left to post on the web. End May remains our hoped for deadline.
2. Michener Arts Museum Recording Solebury and Bucks County Artists Project opened with MAM's Docents, March 3d. Objective would be to recruit one or more docents to record oral histories of living artists currently in MAM's index of artists. Presentation made to +/- 25 docents Tuesday March 3 went well and we wait for their follow up. STHS & Oral History Web site(s) very well received..all of them loved it.
3. Historic Carversville Society project has slowed due to their volunteer's time being taken for family health reasons. All good intentions remain and we hope to take this up again in April.
5. Will Rivinus' 5 interviews are now on our Web site. Will has expressed interest in doing a 6th on the topic of his major book: the Delaware and Lehigh National Heritage Corridor. We have added this to the list.
6. A list of possible interviewees is being put together and vetted with various Society members. This will be shared with two volunteer interviewers in March and we will attempt to generate more OH. List in it's current state is attached.
7. Ranulp Bye's daughter, Catherine Bye Caster, contacted us after reading about her Father's OH in the Herald. She greatly appreciated finding them and shared the link with her family. We made copies of the 3 interviews and she gave us in turn an OH of her family talking about the Bye family, and Byecroft. We will determine if this can be posted to the web.
8. Phoebe Taylor, Artist, horsewoman and author
Sally Jagoe knew Phoebe Taylor very well, and we will write up & link Sally's history to the Michener web site. In addition Sally lent me 7-8 small pamphlet/books Phoebe Taylor authored, illustrated and published. They are extremely charming and we will see how to scan them and put them and her on the the web site. Her Oral History from the Michener files prompted this follow up.
