Wearing my hat as web consultant for the Solebury Township Historical Society, I would like to ask your permission to continue a proposed web-site project.

The Society is considering publishing locally created cook books on the web site. Two of the main ones are Bucks Cooks I and II. As you know, these two books had very large sales, 55,000 and 10,000, but are now out of print. Although these were never copyrighted, the Society is asking permission of the vestry to scan them and publish them on the web.

The books would be published in .pdf form, and if Trinity wanted they could put a link on their web page so that visitors could see the books easily. The link could be to either the main cook book page or to the actual .pdfs of the books.
