SOLEBURY PARK SOLD

To be Occupied as a Religious Camp
Ground

Solebury Deer Park, containing 76 acres has been sold by Charles Edward Foulke, real estate agent, New Hope, for Hugh B. Eastburn of Bristol, to John Zimmerman, Jr., of Philadelphia. The large pavilion and other buildings will be repaired, bungalows will be built on brow of hill overlooking Aquetong lake. The creek on the back part of the property next to the railroad will be dammed and a lake made for swimming and other purposes. Possession will be given March 1st. The property will be used and occupied as a religious camp.
