Larger projects include

And he can star in his own video that can be posted online, presented as a program, and copied for publication. That would require some video editing, but we can apply for a arts and culture grant to help with that

In addition, I helped out with the NHS Lower School visit to the Schoolhouse. I suggest we make an outline of what we presented and store it for future use. We might consider developing a few 45 minute programs for such occasions that we can dig out of mothballs when needed.
