

## Archive Report July 2016

The street index to the houses filed by tax number has been found. It was put in a top drawer face down by a tall person. We also have an more recent (2005) School District census which lists all properties in Solebury Township and gives the tax numbers as well. So we are in good shape for researching houses in the Township.

The requests for information, mainly by email, have been either inquiries about ancestors or the family homestead. We have been able to answer some of these fully, as in the history of the Magills in Carversville, or not, as in the mid-19<sup>th</sup> century marriage between a Randall and a Hartley, for which there is no evidence in any of the sources we used, including the Buck County Intelligencer Marriage Notes, 1835-1860. We have had a request from Adrienne Romano of the Michener about an art collection of the New Hope-Solebury School District.. Neither I nor Marilyn Lanctot have ever run across any mention of it while we were cataloging the school archives—which are mainly class records of the one-room school houses. However, we will do our best to find some reference to it.

Marilyn and I have begun to read through the summary in the CCHA report to see what lies ahead to do.
