Founded in 1785, the historic Lumberville landmark has doggedly weathered floods, hurricanes, countless wars, economic crises and political upheavals. Today Tinsman's is known for it's quality building materials and exceptional service.

Bill and Tom Tinsman are the fifth generation to carry on the family business. Each are proud to have sons, Will and TJ, respectively, who are the sixth generation to take leadership roles in the company.

Since everyone loved the beautiful location of our picnic last year, the Tinsman's have graciously agreed to have us visit again this year. The 2018 picnic will be held behind the lower lumberyard, beyond the
